Water Smart Gardening Simply means selecting plants native to our climate in soil that has been amended with compost so, when established, they require less water to thrive. Always water according to the Denver Water schedule, amending with hand watering if necessary, and it's best to use drip lines for each plant versus using overhead spray heads for your plant beds if you want to save water. If you are looking for hardy perennials, you CAN'T beat purple coneflowers, black eyed susan, coreopsis, or yarrow for a start. And ornamental grasses work well in our semi-arid climate, especially in mass plantings such as a grouping of "Karl Foerster" feather reed grass, maiden hair grass and hardy dwarf grass.

# LAWN MAINTENANCE There are lots of things that can help you improve the appearance of your lawn. Using a pre-emergent in the early Spring to prevent dandelions is a lot easier than digging each plant up after the bloom and before the seeds spread everywhere! Also, be sure to consider applying a surfactant, or "wetting agent" to the brown patches in your lawn. It can make a BIG difference in greening things up! Without an effective way to



deliver sufficient moisture to your

turf, just top dressing dry patches in

your yard is actually the WORST

thing you can do!
