

What Does The Charter HOA Do For You?

- **The HOA Board:** multiple members from your community who volunteer their time to keep our community safe, encourage neighbors to engage with one another, and maintain the beauty of our neighborhood.
- **Advocacy:** meeting with the Lone Tree Police Department (LTPD), attending City Council Meetings, and informing residents about city and state legislation that could impact homes in The Charter.
- **Property Values:** ensuring residents follow the Architectural Control Committee (ACC) rules and regulations regarding property maintenance, appearance, and improvements, as well as proper storage of recreational vehicles. Properties within an active HOA sell for 5-6% more than one without an HOA.
- **Standards:** homeowners comply with guidelines called Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions (CCR's) found in your Deed of Trust package at the time of closing.
- **Neighborhood Watch Program:** this dedicated partnership with the Lone Tree Police Department (LTPD) is comprised of volunteers in our neighborhood community and enhances safety.
- **Neighborhood Events:** to create a sense of community, we organize Easter and Summer events, in addition to our holiday celebration. These may include a food truck, emergency vehicles, door prizes, kids' games and activities, and neighborhood information.
- **Holiday Celebration:** a sleigh ride through the neighborhood with Belgian horses and holiday singers, cocoa and cookies at the Civic Center, a visit with Santa, and holiday bells for the children.
- **Yard of the Month:** \$50 gift card awarded in June, July, and August. This award is given to the member home with the most beautiful yard that month. In December, \$50 is also awarded to the home with the most elegant holiday décor.
- **Annual Newsletter:** goes out to each of the 312 homes in The Charter neighborhood to keep our neighbors informed on what is happening in our community.
- **Neighborhood Updates:** share time-sensitive information via email with The Charter neighbors about safety issues in our neighborhood like the presence of a bear or mountain lion, car theft/break-ins, home break-ins, etc. Contact us at myhoacharter@gmail.com
- **Expenses:** we carry HOA liability insurance and pay a variety of fees to include State of Colorado registration fees and legal fees. These continue to increase year after year.
